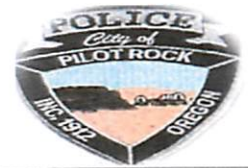
CITY COUNCIL VACANCY

New transportation opportunity for Veterans.

Pilot Rock residents now have more transportation opportunities available to them through "The People Mover" operated by the Grant County Transportation District. Every Tuesday only, excluding major holidays, The People Mover stops at Pilot Rock (Pavillion) at 9:00 a.m. going to the VA Clinic in Walla Walla, Washington and returns back to Pilot Rock at 5:29 p.m. In addition the People Mover bus makes stops at St. Anthony's Hospital, Wal-Mart, Old West Federal Credit Union in Pendleton and Fry's True Value in Milton-Freewater.

This is also an opportunity for residents to go in to Pendleton earlier at 9:00 a.m. and return back on the Kayak bus at noon. Both Kayak Public Transit and the People Mover bus schedules are available at the Pilot Rock Post Office.
