FROM THE CHIEF'S DESK

It has recently been brought to my attention that someone has been dumping cats and/or kittens in the Pilot Rock area, leaving them to die. This is totally reprehensible and will not be tolerated. There are several laws that prohibit such an act and all of them can carry jail time. Charges can include Animal Neglect I, Animal Neglect II, Animal Abuse I and Animal Abuse II. I would ask the community to keep a watch out for those persons who might be responsible. Information such as vehicle description (s) and/or license plate numbers would be very helpful. Your tips will remain anonymous. Any information can be called in to the police department at (541) 443-1224 or to the City/County Dispatch Center at (541) 966-3651.

Finally, I would also like to take this moment to thank those who came and participated in the National Night Out event that was held on August 6th, 2019.
