SPECIAL MONTHLY RATES FOR WATER SERVICE

City Council established special water service rates for low-income residents. Low-income citizens pay a minimum monthly rate for up to 1,500 cubic feet of water. For any amount over 1,500 cubic feet, the regular residential rates apply. A low-income citizen is a person whose income, earned or unearned, is not more than the federal poverty guidelines for farm individuals or families who owns no real property other than their principal home and who is dependent upon his own resources for support, living alone or with members of his family who are dependent on him for support.

Applications will be available on January 27, 2024. A sworn statement of income & financial resources is required. For more information, contact City Hall.
