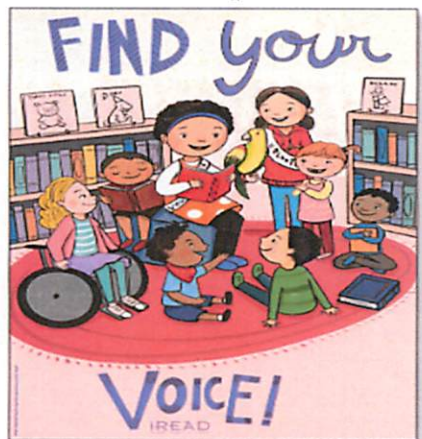

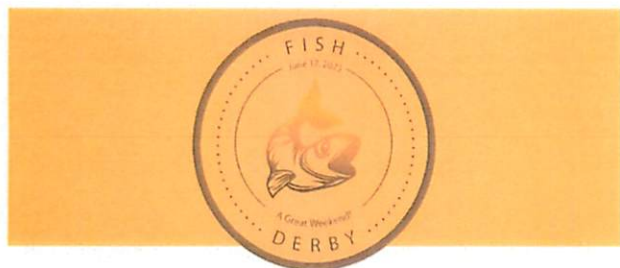

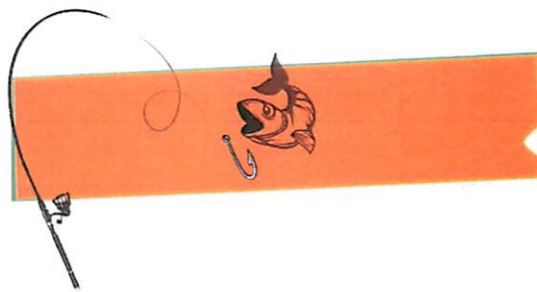

Summer Safety for Pets



Pets should never be left inside a vehicle. Temperatures can increase rapidly and become fatal.

Supervise your dog when they are swimming. Rinse off any salt, sand or chlorine.

Limit exercise to early morning or late afternoon to avoid the heat of the day.

Stay on top of grooming to avoid trapping excess heat.

Signs of Heatstroke

- Heavy panting
- Excessive drooling
- Vomiting
- Lack of coordination
- Excessive thirst
- Difficulty breathing
- Acting tired or refusing to move

Move your pet to a cool place and contact a veterinarian if you see any of these signs

Ways to Keep Your Pet Cool

- Frozen treats
- Sprinkler
- Fresh, cool water
- Provide shade
- Kiddie pool
- Air conditioning
