**The next City Council meeting is September 20, 2022 with the following tentative agenda:**

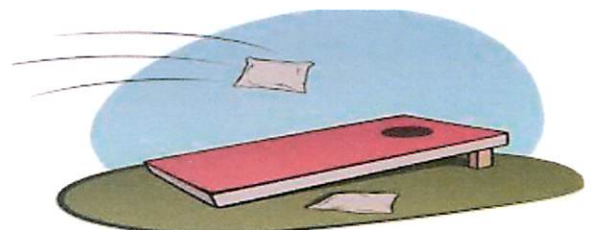

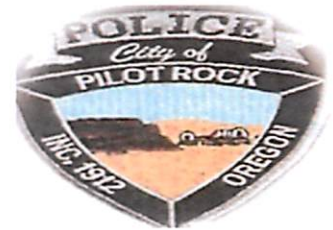
