### PUBLIC MEETINGS

Last week Governor Kate Brown announced executive order 20-16 "Keep Government Working". It is the order that provides necessary measures to ensure safe public meetings. It states that the governing body of a public body shall hold public meetings & hearings by telephone, video, or through some other electronic or virtual means whenever possible. Therefore, the City of Pilot Rock will be having public meetings via phone conferencing. The public will be able to call in and listen live. All issues or requests that need to be addressed by our City Council or Budget Committee are required to be sent to the City Recorder no later than the day before by 5pm prior to scheduled meeting. The public will also be able to make comments live via text message or email during the meeting. The following is the schedule for the month of May.

6pm May 13 - First budget committee meeting

7pm May 19 - Regular Council meeting

6pm May 27 - Second budget committee meeting

Hopefully we won't need a third budget meeting but will schedule for early June if necessary. We will have the approved budget ready to be adopted at the June 16 Council meeting.
