PILOT ROCK ELECTIONS 2020

On November 3, Pilot Rock residents will be tasked with electing three Council seats that are expiring December 31, 2020. The term for City Council is 4 years and they are staggered so that the entire Council does not expire at the same time. As it is very difficult to find citizens willing and able to devote the time and effort required, we are always hopeful that existing Councilors will run for reelection. However, fresh faces with fresh ideas are always encouraged. If you have been contemplating running for a seat on the Pilot Rock City Council, please consider the following:

To qualify as a candidate, you must be:

- A resident of the City of Pilot Rock who has resided continuously in the City during the 12 months immediately preceding the election they are filing for
- ◆ A resident of the City of Pilot Rock when elected and assuming office for which elected
- A candidate may not be an employee of the City of Pilot Rock
- Candidates may only run for one seat at the same election

Election information packets and filing forms will be available in City Hall and on the City website in April.
