The next City Council meeting is scheduled for
Tuesday, Feb. 4, at 7 pm in Council Chambers.

- 1. Appointing the Budget Officer:** Council appointed Teri Porter to Budget Officer for the 2015 fiscal year.
- 2. Public Hearing to consider a Conditional Use permit at 227 SW Birch St:** Mr. Perrine would like to build a repair shop that would include a small residence for himself. The business would be called Perrine's Repair. Council approved the Conditional Use permit. Any persons wishing to appeal the decision must do so by February 5, 2014.
- 3. Public Hearing to consider a request to Rezone the property at 106 S. Alder (the old doctors office):** Mr. Fenton is remodeling the building to serve as a duplex. Each unit has 2 bedrooms. Mr. Fenton was hoping to purchase the adjoining property to the north, unfortunately the owner and Mr. Fenton are too far apart as to price at this time. There was discussion regarding parking for the residents of the units as well as the easement needed when the stairs to the high school are replaced. Council approved the request to rezone and granted a 1 year variance regarding the parking ordinance. Any persons wishing to appeal the decision must do so by February 5, 2014.
- 4. Appointing a Council President:** Council appointed Kacie Moss to continue as Council President.
- 5. Executive Session to discuss Real Property Transactions regarding the Koch property as well as the Sundown project.** When Council returned to regular session, Council approved a letter of intent for the Sundown project and directed Teri to draft a letter for the appointed Council members who are hoping to meet with Mrs. Koch.
