Next City Council Meeting April 7th

It is certainly a tribute to the girls, their coaches, parents and fans who have followed the season.

City Of Pilot Rock

Council met with the city engineers and staff for a Wastewater Lagoon Upgrade Work Session, on March 16, 2015, at 6pm. The following was discussed:

- The City is currently dealing with a DEQ requirement to upgrade the lagoons to ensure compliance.
- The Waste Water Facility Plan (WWFP) is a document intended to outline wastewater system needs for now and for a 20 year planning period.
- Review of population growth.
- Discussion of the existing system; collection, lift station and primary lagoon.
- Four (4) options were presented. Each costing from approx. \$2,083,000 to \$2,623,000. Pros and cons were discussed for each.
- Sewer rates and preliminary financial information. The City's sewer rates are too low to qualify for special interest rates and grants. Currently the sewer rate is \$18.00 each month. The rate would need to be \$40.36, to qualify.
- There was discussion of loans and gradually raising the sewer rate each year to pay for the loan.
- A second work session is scheduled for May 18, 2015, at 6pm in the Council Chambers.

The following topics were discussed at the last Council meeting.

- Representatives of BMCC were present to discuss need for the BMCC Bond. Council gave the bond their endorsement.
- Council approved the use of the Council Chambers for AA meetings every Saturday at 7pm.
- Regarding the additional charges for Umatilla County Dispatch services, Council was presented with a report from Sergeant Stallings outlining the services. The report also included what each city is currently charged for the service. Council asked Sergeant Stallings to invite Captain Lieuallen of Umatilla county Dispatch to attend a future Council meeting.
- Council approved a vacation request.
- Council approved a resolution transferring funds.
- Council appointed Councilor Perkins as liaison to the Planning Commission.

Future meetings will consider:

- Recruiting a new Police Chief
- DEQ requirement to upgrade the lagoons.
- Replacement of the stairs or route over the bluff to school.
- A water booster station near NW Delwood.
- RV Park Ordinance.




