4. Council approved the costs of the annual street sweeping.
5. Council agreed to sponsor the annual clean up day to be held on May 10th.
6. Teri reported that the Planning Commission had their first meeting on April 7th and a Public Hearing is scheduled for April 21, 2014, to consider a variance at 998 SW Cedar.



April 26: First Citizens and Business Excellence Awards Banquet




