City Of Pilot Rock

The following topics were discussed at the last Council meeting.

- Council approved sponsoring Clean Up Day, to be held May 9th, and May 6th for seniors.
- Steve Draper reported on the progress regarding the stairs to the High School. Council asked that he present a staff report with options and cost estimates.
- Jim Hatley understands that an extension of the sewer line to his annexed property will be done at his cost. He asked council to consider allowing him to be reimbursed as other property owners hook onto the line. Council agreed to consider an agreement to be presented at a future Council meeting for approval.
- Upon the Planning Commissions recommendation, Council approved a Home Occupation permit at 281 NE Cherry.
- Anthony and Viktor of A&V Investments were present to give Council an update on the required renovations to the old Masonite plant. They stated most will be done by the July 2015 deadline, but asked for a 5 month extension to complete the primary power installation.

Future meetings will consider:

- Recruiting a new Police Chief
- DEQ requirement to upgrade the lagoons.
- Replacement of the stairs or route over the bluff to school.
- A water booster station near NW Delwood.
- RV Park Ordinance.

The 2nd Budget Meeting for the 2015-2016 fiscal year will be held April 29, 2015, at 7pm in the Council Chambers. This is a public meeting all who are interested are welcome to attend.

There will be beverages and cookies served at intermission.


