City Of Pilot Rock

The following topics were discussed at the last Council meeting.

- Sheriff Rowan and Captain Lieuallen of the Umatilla County Dispatch were present at Councils request, to explain the additional fees that are being assessed for dispatch fees. In the past State Revenue 911 funds were paid to Umatilla County for the dispatch service. Recent changes to the statute requires that the 911 funds be used strictly for 911 services and can no longer be used to fund dispatch. The new dispatch fee is based on population. If using the population formula the City of Pilot Rock would owe over \$24,000 each year. Captain Lieuallen has been negotiating a \$6,000 annual fee for the next fiscal year and it is anticipated that the fee will go up each year until we are caught up.
- Council adopted a resolution reinstating the Equipment Replacement and Water Project funds strictly for audit purposes.
- Council approved transferring money in the Economic Development fund to cover unexpected cost in legal and surveying fees.
- Council appointed Councilor Perkins to the interview board for hire a police chief.
- At the last meeting after a citizen raised a doubt that Mr. Hatley's request for a Recapture Agreement, (so that, as each new developer hooks on, he can be reimbursed for expenses in extending the sewer main), should first go before the planning commission. As directed by Council, a staff report was submitted explaining that the issue of cost reimbursement for extending a sewer line, is not a land use issue and should not be presented to the planning commission.

Future meetings will consider:

- Recruiting a new Police Chief
- DEQ requirement to upgrade the lagoons.
- Replacement of the stairs or route over the bluff to school.
- A water booster station near NW Delwood.
- RV Park Ordinance.

The Budget Hearing for the 2015-2016 fiscal year will be held May 19, 2015, at 7pm in the Council Chambers. This is a public meeting all who are interested are welcome to attend.


Book Sale at the Pilot Rock Library




