To get into the spooky holiday mood, PRHS Theater Department will be presenting *The Legend of Sleepy Hollow* by Clay Presley and adapted from the story by Washington Irving. The production will be October 23 at 8:00 PM in the PRHS Cafetorium. Doors will open at 7:30 PM. Tickets are available from students or at the door: Adults \$5, Jr./Sr. High Students \$3 and Elementary students FREE.

The plot of the story is Icabod Crane (played by Justin George) is the new school master assigned to Sleepy Hollow a small town by the Hudson River.
