The next scheduled City Council meeting is Tuesday, Dec. 3 in City Council Chambers @ 7 pm

**Public Hearing:** Council heard testimony from citizens regarding the application to rezone the property at 326 NW 4th (The Old Motel). Jodean Bronson states that it is no longer a motel and is now a single family home. Council granted the request to rezone the property from commercial to residential.

**Public Hearing:** Council heard testimony from citizens regarding the application to annex the property owned by Patrick Dougherty on NW Cedar across from the Mill. Mr. Dougherty will be wanting City services such a water and sewer. Council approved the application to annex.

**Planning Commission:** Teri Porter asked to reduced the number of planning commission members from 7, to a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 7. Council agreed to amend the ordinance.

**Chief Richman Vacation Payout:** Since Chief Richman has not been able to use up any of his vacation time, Council approved paying out 160 hours of Chief Richman's accumulated vacation as well as 18 hours of his personal leave.

**A&V Investments Approval to Sublet:** Anthony and Viktor of A&V Investments requested and were granted permission to sublet a portion of their industrial property to Mt. West and T-Mobile.

**Planning Issues:** Council accepted an application from John Fenton to rezone the property at 110 N. Alder (the old doctors office). The public hearing will be held in January. Council also heard from Mr. Edgar Perrine who has submitted an application for a conditional use. He would like to build a shop with a small residence inside. Says he will operate a maintenance and repair business. Council accepted his application and the public hearing is set for December 3, 2013.

**Councilor Appointed:** Council approved the application of Raymond Dougherty and appointed him Councilor. Councilor Dougherty will be sworn in at the beginning of the December 3, 2013, meeting.

**Executive Session:** Council went into executive session to consider a letter from the City attorney to Council. When Council came out of executive session a motion was made to resume the monthly payments to Mary Koch.




