Voice of Democracy Contest

Congratulations go out to local VFW Voice of Democracy winners high school first place Kaleigh Waggoner, third place Haley Fitzpatrick and Junior High Patriots Pen first place Abby Rigby. Since 1947, the Voice of Democracy has been the Veterans of Foreign Wars' (VFW's) premier scholarship program. Each year, more than 50,000 high school students compete for more than \$2.3 million in scholarships and incentives. Students compete by writing and recording a broadcast script on an annual patriotic theme. This year's theme was, Is Our Constitution Still Relevant? Prizes and scholarships are awarded at the local, district, state and national level. Department (State) winners receive an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C.. The top eight winners from the Pilot Rock Social Studies class traveled to KUMA radio station in October to record their original 3-5 minute essay on CD. They are Megan Matthews, KyliSue Johnson, Kaleigh Waggoner, Haley Fitzpatrick, Paeli Thorne, Josh Barkley, Jacob Hendrickson and Patrick Myers. Kaleigh and Abby will go on to compete at the District level. All three ladies will be invited to a luncheon in their honor in December where they will pick up their scholarship checks ranging from \$100 to \$500 dollars. 
