



The next regularly scheduled City Council Meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 6, 2012 at 7 PM in the City Council Chambers. All are welcome!

### Of Special Interest

The March 6 City Council meeting will introduce Lindsey Warness, the Forest Products Analyst from Boise Cascade, presenting a special program. All are invited to attend. Our Eastern Oregon National Forests are in crisis. National Forest Management provided county funds for schools and roads until the year 2000 when the Secure Rural Schools Act of 2000 was introduced. This act gave money to counties in lieu of the money these counties once received from the harvest on the National Forest. Lindsay will join the March 6 Pilot Rock City Council meeting to discuss this quagmire in further detail and outline some opportunities for action with regards to fiber supply for the local mills.


