

Cooking Matters is a cooking-based nutrition education program that teaches families how to prepare healthy, tasty meals on a limited budget. Participants practice fundamental lessons and making a healthy meal for a family of four on a \$10 budget. Each family will take home with them a bag of groceries after each lesson so they can practice preparing the recipe taught that day.

The Pendleton 'Community Foods Group' is hosting a **FREE** Six- Week Session of Cooking Classes. Our goal is to create a long-term solution to hunger by giving people the confidence and ability to be more self-sufficient in their food choices and behaviors. Team volunteers will challenge students to reconsider food preferences and habits and teach cooking methods, nutrition, food safety, practical shopping and meal planning – skills that increase food security and quality of life.
