Pilot Rock High School and Ukiah High School Theater Departments are working together on producing the play *Charlie and the Chocolate Factory*. The show dates at Pilot Rock Jr. High Café-gym-atorium are Friday and Saturday, April 27 & 28, and Friday, May 4. The show will play at Ukiah High School Gym on Thursday, May 3. All performances will start at 8:00 PM with doors opening at 7:30. General Admission ticket prices are \$5 for adults, \$3 for students and senior citizens and \$2 for preschool.

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory is the timeless story of the poor young boy, Charlie Bucket, who more than anything wants to find one of the five "Golden Tickets" which allows for the bearer to tour Willy Wonka's chocolate factory. He finds a ticket and takes his Grandpa Joe to the wonderful world of Willy Wonka. The other four children, Augustus, Veruca, Violet and Mike show their true colors as they one-by-one disappear from the touring group. Adult and children alike will enjoy the antic of Willy Wonka and his helpers the Oompa Loompas.

This production is the first time the Pilot Rock and Ukiah High School Theater Departments have tried a cooperative show. There have been some difficulties to overcome, but it has still been a fun show to work on together. The main characters have been cast at each school and then will play Oompa Loompas when visiting the other's school for the play production. The stages are quite different in size and structure. Lighting and backdrops will be adjusted depending on the location. Theater students, however, are flexible and can adapt with ease. Teachers Norma Barber at Ukiah and Annie Tester at Pilot Rock came up with the idea last fall and decided to try it out. It is a great way to get students to interact in a non-competitive situation. In a theater production, they will definitely need to work together.


