## CTUIR Board of Trustees Mural Blessing on Thursday, May 30 @ 2 pm

The next scheduled City Council meeting will be held on June 4th, 2013. To be placed on the agenda, please contact City Hall.

#### Note from the Mayor:

On June 18, a joint meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation and the City Council will be held to discuss issues of common interest/concerns. We are delighted to be hosting this historic meeting. - vc

The following topics were discussed at the May 8, 2013, meeting:

1. David Blanc, the City attorney was present to discuss the continuation of the Koch payments. Council went into executive session, and then came out with a motion to direct David to draft a letter for Councils approval.
2. There was discussion regarding extending the water main down NW Cedar another 820', anticipating an annexation. But since no formal annexation request had been submitted it was considered a dead issue.
3. Council passed a motion to put \$110,000 of the down payment money, from the sale of the industrial property, as a lump sum payment on the LOCAP water project loan.
4. American Tower had submitted a proposal to change the current lease to an easement and they would like to purchase the easement for one lump sum. Steve Draper made a strong argument that the current lease is a steady revenue source. Council agreed not to sell the lease at this time.
5. There is ongoing concern that the Bike Pit board is not complying with Councils request to be present at the Council meetings. Council agreed to resend a letter certified mail and is prepared to take further action.

The Budget Committee met on May 22, 2013. The review of the proposed budget was completed and approved by the committee. Staff would like to thank Karen Stanton, Kay Thorn, Scott Segar, Michelle Casady, Lela Thieme and Jackie Carey, for dedicating their valuable time to the very important budget process. We couldn't do it without you. A public hearing is scheduled for June 4, 2013, to discuss the approved budget. A copy of the approved budget will be available at City Hall on May 28, 2013.

Just a Reminder: Don't forget to get your dog licensed! The fee is \$3 for altered dogs and \$5 for non-altered. Stop by City Hall and we will take care of it for you. Also, we have 3 Notaries at City Hall - the fee is \$5 per notary.







is a caring, innovative network of quality

**Umatilla Morrow Head Start is opening a classroom in Pilot Rock!  
Our classroom will be located in the Pilot Rock Elementary School  
beginning September 2013!**

The Head Start Program, funded by federal and state grants, offers comprehensive services which include:

**Education** – Develop each child’s potential for success and ready for Kindergarten skills through enhancing their social, emotional, physical, self-help and cognitive development. Staff utilize parents as the children’s primary teacher.

**Health & Nutrition** – Provide children with balanced meal and snacks through a variety of wholesome foods served family style in the classroom. Staff assist parents to coordinate well child exams, dental exams, and nutrition assessments each year.

**Family & Community** – Offer parents opportunities and support for growth so that they can identify their own strengths, needs and interests and find their own solutions. Staff provide referrals to community resources and aid in emergency/crisis intervention.

- ◆ To be eligible for **Head Start (HS)**: your child must be 3 or 4 on or before Sept. 1.
- ◆ **Low Income**: Your family income must meet the Federal Guidelines (the program is able to enroll a limited number of families who do not meet the income guidelines when children have identified high risks and/or special needs)

**Center Base Model:**

- ◆ Classes held 4 days/week, 3 1/2 hrs/day
- ◆ Families receive 2 education home visits per year, 2 parent/staff conferences/year and at least 3 social services visits/year
- ◆ Bus transportation is provided, with some limitations
- ◆ Located in: Hermiston, Umatilla, Irrigon, Pendleton, Pilot Rock, Milton-Freewater, Stanfield, Wallowa, Enterprise & John Day
