

*Livestock Recordkeeping Workshop*  
*Free and Open to the Public*

A two-part Livestock Recordkeeping Workshop is being held on May 11 and May 18, 2011 at 5:00 pm at the Cayuse/Umatilla Room of the Governance Center, Mission, OR. (Please use the East entrance of the building.) The sessions will focus on basic recordkeeping techniques which will help participants gain the tools they need to meet the requirements of participating in certain USDA programs as well as being able to do basic income and expense analyses to aid in decision-making. Basic recordkeeping skills are needed to participate in the Beginning Farmer and Rancher Loan Program, some practices of the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP), the Disaster Aid program and others. The workshop will help both those already operating an agricultural enterprise who would like to improve their recordkeeping skills as well as those just starting out, large or small. Though the focus will be on Livestock Records, the basic skills taught will be applicable to other types of enterprises as well. Tiicham Conservation District will be hosting the workshops, partnering with Indian Nations Conservation Alliance (INCA) and USDA's Risk Management Agency (RMA). The RMA will also be present with some of their risk management information. The recordkeeping course, which will cover both paper and computer methods will be presented by Tiicham's District Coordinator, Jim Smith. The sessions are free and open to all.
