Important Reminder:

The Burn Ban will be in effect
June 15 -September 15. Burning inside City limits
will only be allowed recreationally.

After reviewing City Code 3.20.060 Public Safety Act it has come to our attention that there is a \$5.00 late fee per Ordinance 541 (3.20.060) that was effective July 1, 2010. It states that “late charges in the amount of \$5.00 per month shall be attached to any public safety surcharges not received within 30 days of billing”.

Effective July 1st, 2012 the City will start enforcing the \$5.00 late fee for all public safety surcharges not received within 30 days of billing, as per City Code 3.20.060 (Ordinance 541). This will be in addition to the \$10.00 late fee being assessed on water accounts with a past due balance.

For the past 2 years this late fee has not been assessed on any accounts.






