City of Pilot Rock Council Seat Vacancies

The City of Pilot Rock will have three City Council seats become vacant at the completion of the 2012 calendar year. The terms run for four (4) years, with a term of service expiring in December 2016. Positions require residency within the Pilot Rock city limits for a minimum of one year.

The City Council meets the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of every month, at 7:00pm in the Council Chambers. If you are interested in running for City Council, please pick up the elections packet from Teri Porter, City Recorder, at 144 N. Alder, Pilot Rock, OR, 97868.

Closing date for submitting candidacy forms is 5:00 p.m., August 20, 2012. Eligible candidates will appear on the November 6, 2012 ballot. Elected candidates will be sworn into office at the first meeting in January, 2013.


