


### Property Insurance Rates

Over the past few months, several City residents have contacted the Fire Department to ask why their property insurance rates had increased as much as 50% over the previous year. In every case, their insurance companies had mistakenly rated their properties as being in a Protection Class 9 (PC9) and that caused the increase.

If you live within the Pilot Rock city limits, your property should be rated as a PC5, not a PC9. We aren't sure where the insurance companies are getting the bad information, and this has involved several companies, so if you have noticed a sizeable increase in your property insurance premiums, contact your agent and ask what they are using for the protection class.


