The following topics were discussed at the last Council Meeting on

September 18, 2012

James Williams - Rock Rec: James Williams addressed Council with his plans to open up a Recreational Center in the old doctors office at the end of Main St. He plans to have pin ball machines, a pool table, computers etc. Council directed him to Chief Richman and City Hall to work out the details and fees.

Low Income Application: A low income application was approved, granting the qualifying resident a lower utility rate.

Vacation Request: Council approved vacation requests for City employees Steve Draper and Tim Britain.

Appointment of Council President: Council appointed Councilor Rowe as Council President. Councilor Kirk was appointed to review the monthly financial reports.

Bring Staff Back to the Table: Councilor Rowe made a motion to have the entire staff sit at the front table. The motion was passed with Councilors Moss, Corwin, Hinkle, Rowe and Kirk voting Yes and Councilor Baleztena voting No.

More Minutes in the Newsletter: Councilor Rowe suggested putting more detailed information regarding the minutes in the newsletter.

There was discussion that the newsletter encourages people to visit the City website to read more or they could stop by City Hall.

Councilor Rowe feels that it is a good tool to keep people informed.





A teacher that once had a dream of being a fighter pilot chose us over his passion.
