The next scheduled City Council meeting will be May 7th, 2013 @ 7 pm in Council Chambers. If you have an item to be placed on the agenda, please notify City Hall.

The following topics were discussed at the April 16, 2013, meeting:

1. Council approved the new Department Head evaluation worksheets and process. Each employee will be asked to fill out an evaluation worksheet on their supervisor. In addition each department head will fill one out on each other. Council feels that getting this information from the employees who have firsthand knowledge of the department head would be more effective.
2. Council approved changing the Part-time office Clerk job description to include housekeeping. A \$1 Increase was also approved.
3. There was discussion on the \$300 a month rent payments made to the Koch family. Council will review the history.
4. A concrete slab will be poured under the covered area alongside the log yard on Hwy 395. When it is complete, the area will serve as an information rest area, with a map of Pilot Rock and annual events etc. This is a Downtown Association project.
5. There was discussion about the Bike Pit 501c3. Council asked that the Bike Pit president and or vice president report on the progress every 2 months beginning May 7, 2013.

Minutes from the April 16, 2013, meeting will be posted to the website www.cityofpilotrock.org after they are approved at the next meeting on May 7, 2013. All Citizens are encouraged to attend Council Meetings.


The Pilot Rock High School Theater Department Presents:
