City of Pilot Rock

The next scheduled City Council meeting will be April 16, 2013 @ 7 pm in Council Chambers. If you have an item to be placed on the agenda please notify City Hall.

Congratulations to Josie Forester on her appointment to the City Council.

The following topics were discussed at the April 2, 2013 Council Meeting:

1. Council agreed to sponsor the annual clean up day.
2. Council approved vacation for Steve Draper
3. Council gave approval for expenses related to Street Sweeping and Asphalt paving.
4. Council was made aware of changes to the Budget Calendar.
5. Council gave approval to apply for Grants to help fund the Swim program.
6. Councilor Rowe brought up several issues such as; Employee Medical Insurance, Phone expenses at the Cabin and City Shop, Reduction in internet costs and appropriation of the \$111,000 down payment from the sale of the industrial property. There was lengthy discussion as Council and citizens felt these things need to be addressed in the budget.
7. Councilor Moss and staff have presented ideas for the most effective way to evaluate the department heads. Council agreed to have a work session before the next meeting to nail it down.
8. Council appointed Jodie Forster to City Councilor.
9. John Taylor inquired about: 1. The status of the Espresso property, which is current on payments. 2. Which department head is responsible for contracts? Council agreed that the Public Works Director and City Recorder play a dual role in following up on existing contracts and asked to have their job description address as such, then submit to Council for approval. 3. A breakdown of employees wages and benefits, which will be presented at the budget meetings. 4. The proper handling of excess vacation time. Council explained that that issue has already been addressed.

It was a really good turn out of citizens at this meeting, we appreciate everyone that attended and encourage all citizens to attend. Minutes from the April 2, 2013, meeting will be posted to the website www.cityofpilotrock.org after they are approved at the next Council meeting on April 16, 2013. 
