## City of Pilot Rock

The next scheduled City Council meeting will be Feb. 5 @ 7 pm in Council Chambers. If you have an item to be placed on the agenda please notify City Hall.

The following topics were discussed at the January 15, 2013, meeting:

1. A Resolution was passed transferring appropriations from the Contingency line item of the General Fund to offset miscalculations made during the budget process, to cover a pay adjustment and to cover additional attorney fees incurred during the sale of the industrial property.
2. Teri Porter was appointed as the Budget Officer for the 2014 fiscal year.
3. Kacie Moss was appointed as Council President.
4. A low income application was approved.
5. Resolution 545 was passed extending workers compensation coverage to volunteers of the City of Pilot Rock. This is done annually.
6. Jimmy Doherty addressed Council inquiring if the industrial property between the bike pit and the gun club was for sale. Council stated that that it is for sale and requested that Jimmy return within 90 days with a business plan and proposal.
7. Chris Robinson of the Bike Pit requested approval to use the Bike Pit on March 9th and 10th for their annual fund raiser as well as October 13 and November 17 for races. Council approved the dates. Chris committed to being available to Council and citizens to answer questions.
8. Teri Porter informed council that Kimberley (pt office clerk) will be resigning the end of the month and asked Council's approval to post the position. Council approved. Councilor Kirk expressed her interest in the position. Teri stated that she feels Shawna would be an excellent choice, but asked to be removed from the selection process as it is well known that she is friends with Shawna and did not want there to be any question that the person getting the position got it because they are the best fit. If Councilor Kirk was granted the position she would step down from her position as City Councilor. Council accepted the responsibility of reviewing the applications at the next meeting. They will then select those they will interview and make their selection from there.

There is an opening on the Budget Committee. If you live within the Pilot Rock city limits and would like to be part of the City of Pilot Rock budget process, please stop by City Hall for an application.
