





Dear Pilot Rock Community,

While we are communicating this news directly to our Pilot Rock customers next week in a formal letter, many of you already know that Sterling Bank has made the difficult decision to consolidate our Pilot Rock branch into our Pendleton branch on June 27, 2013. Sterling Bank will continue to operate during its regular business hours until that date. All of us at Sterling hope to continue to serve each of you until that date and beyond.

As many of you know, Sterling Bank operates in a highly competitive financial services market, and our viability depends on maintaining a tenuous balance of supply and demand. Without sufficient demand, we simply cannot afford to supply the range of products and services you are accustomed to, particularly with the convenience and fair value you have rightfully come to expect.

We did not make this decision lightly, but deemed it necessary as the Pilot Rock branch currently operates at a loss and has for the last several years. In making our final decision, we spent time in Pilot Rock and had numerous conversations with business leaders and elected officials. We listened to and heard the concerns of the community. Through these conversations, we recognize the impact of Sterling Bank not having a physical bank presence in Pilot Rock.

In an effort to help reduce the impact to Pilot Rock, Sterling is committed to finding alternatives to serve the banking needs of your community. Some of the options we are considering are:

- Having a Sterling banker hold rotating, regular hours in Pilot Rock.
- Installing a state-of-the-art Automated Teller Machine (ATM) that can receive deposits of both currency and checks (up to 30 at a time), provide immediate availability to deposited cash, dispense cash and provide images of deposited items.
- Working side-by-side with the FDIC to ascertain interests from other financial institutions. If there is an interest from another financial institution, Sterling is open to selling its building and fixtures.

While we hope this will ease some of the burden for our customers, we know we are counted on to provide consultative banking solutions, too. We invite each of our customers to come in for a one-on-one meeting to discuss how Sterling Bank can continue to serve your banking needs. Sterling has options, such as remote deposit capture, direct deposit and online banking, that make a trip to a physical branch unnecessary, saving you time in the process.

We know this change is difficult for our Pilot Rock customers. As trust is paramount to any banking relationship, please trust that we will continue to look for solutions, like those mentioned above, to assist you with your personal or business banking needs.
