The next City Council meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 4, at 7 pm in Council Chambers.

The Umatilla Watershed Council will meet in our Council Chambers on Monday, March 24 @ 6 pm. All citizens are encouraged and invited to attend as these meetings deal with the waterways within our county---like East and West Birch Creek! This is your opportunity to be involved! ve

The following topics were discussed at the February 18th meeting

1. Karen Davis and Tracy Hamby of Banner Bank were present and explained their desire to be of service to our community.
2. Mr. Taylor expressed concerns regarding Council Rules.
3. Mrs. Slabik brought up a concern that the water spicket at the City shop should be metered to ensure that the City is properly compensated.
4. Council approve the applications of Joey GrosJacques, Carl Schreiner and Michelle Casady to the Planning Commission. With these appointments the Planning Commission will be up and running once again.
5. Council approved allowing Teri Porter to attend the Northwest Clerks Institute.
6. Council approved a vacation request for Steve Draper.
7. Members of the Bike Pit Board were present to request approval for the next years events dates as well as approval to apply for specific grants. Council granted these requests. The Bike Pit board also announced that they will be developing a contract outlying responsibilities between the bike pit and the City and a possible share in the revenues.
8. John Standley stated that there had been a motion made years ago that once the Bike Pit received their 501c3 status that the City would deed the property over to them and wondered if that motion still had any traction. There was discussion regarding other motions made, Steve stated that he would research it and be prepared for the next meeting.
9. Council was provided with a copy of a section of the Employee handbook which has been updated. Council was asked to review it as it will be on the March 4th agenda for approval.
10. After executive session Council directed Staff to proceed with their attempts to get an agreement between the Koch family and the City.


