City of Pilot Rock

1. Council approved renewing the franchise agreement between the City and Charter Communications.
2. Council accepted the application of Randall Ziegler and appointed him to the Planning Commission.
3. Council granted permission to Teri Porter to attend the FEMA training in Eugene.
4. Council approved a resolution assigning a new address on NW Elder.
5. Council approved a vacation request for Teri Porter
6. Chief Richman informed Council that the newly hired police officer will be attending the police academy this fall.
7. Chief Richman also informed Council that he purchased body cameras for his officers. He also stated that CIS has awarded the City a grant that will pay for half of the cost of the cameras and equipment.
8. Council granted Chief Richman permission to apply for the Bullet proof vest grant.
9. Chief informed Council that he purchased Pet Waste Stations for the park.
10. Steve Draper explained that our Park maintenance person, Sue Gibson, has retired. He is accepting applications, but since it is the end of the season there is no need to fill the position quickly.
11. There was discussion regarding the booster lift station for Hatley development and who should bear the cost. More discussion is needed with Mr. Hatley present at a Council meeting.
12. Teri informed Council that she will be updating the ordinance regarding mobile homes and will bring to Council for approval.
13. Teri is also working on developing an ordinance to regulate RV parks within the City limits.






