The next City Council meeting is scheduled for
Tuesday, April 1, at 7 pm in Council Chambers.

1. Kyle Hill of the Archery Club, received approval from Council to use a portion of the Bike Pit for an archery shoot on April 5, 2014.
2. The Bike Pit Board would like to consult with an attorney before presenting a proposed contract between the Bike Pit and the City. Council tabled the issue.
3. Council approved giving the administrative assistant half of her first year bump to help offset her required contribution into PERS. Council asked that Teri look into making changes to the wage schedule to reflect an increase at 6 months rather than a year.
4. Request for proposals from banking institutions may go out by May.
5. The City has received a warning letter from DEQ, requiring a feasibility study on upgrading our lagoons. Council approved moving forward with looking for grants to fund the study and contact the City engineers to start the process.



Proceeds Will Help Support Pilot Rock Community Days

PILOT ROCK COMMUNITY CENTER CELEBRATES
60TH BIRTHDAY

On March 10th, 1954 Mr. & Mrs. Al Moltke turned over to Pilot Rock, the Deed to the Property which was then developed by community members with mostly donated labor and materials. Farmers and other people in the area, donated their equipment, time, and skills to build, wire, plumb, paint and landscape the facility.

Money was donated and funds were raised in various ways (including a skit put on by members of the community that is on tape at the local Library).

In 1979 a petition was signed by a percentage of the voters in the District to place the question of putting the property onto the tax rolls. This was approved and the boundaries are the same as the school district. At that time a Board of five members was elected to manage the needs and responsibilities of the building, becoming a local government unto itself and not the City of Pilot Rock.

Over the years the board has applied for and received many grants & donations using those funds to purchase furniture, new appliances, paint (inside & out), add new windows and doors, reroof, install a better heating system, add air conditioning, remodel the kitchen and add a storage area for tables & chairs.

With help from the City and Hatley Construction they were able to enlarge and gravel the parking area. Trees were planted around the area and every spring, the students help with cleanup on the bank around the building.


The City of Pilot Rock personnel do the scheduling for use of the building and collect the rental fees for the Board. There is one part time employee to clean and check on the building. We do donate to the City Swim Program.

The building belongs to the Community of Pilot Rock and like the City Park and School Ball Fields, is an asset for everyone to enjoy.


