#### Next City Council Meeting

August 5, 2014 7:00 pm council chambers

1. The contract with Read and Bose was renewed for the 2014 audit.
2. The agreement with the Community Center board was renewed. The board agreed to 4 free scheduled days of use, in return for the services offered by the City.
3. Council approved the purchase of a commercial grade lawn mower, not to exceed \$25,000. The lawn mower would replace the existing mower which is more than 30 years old.
4. Approval was given to transfer funds from contingency to DEQ compliance and equipment replacement, in the Sewer fund.
5. Resolutions were approved assigning addresses. Well house #1 will be 358 SW Delwood, Well house #2 will be 547 SW Delwood. The newly annexed property on NW Cedar will be 611 NW Cedar.
6. Approval was given to apply for the Ready to Read grant for the library.
7. The franchise agreement with Charter Cable was presented to Council as information only. They will be asked to vote on approving it at the next meeting.
8. Council was informed that the Planning Commission held a public hearing and following the appeal period, the commission will present a final partition plat for approval.

**ELECTIONS!!** The Mayor and three council seats are up for election this fall. Anyone interested in running may pick up a packet at City Hall.


