The next scheduled City Council meeting will be held on July 16th, 2013. To be placed on the agenda, please contact City Hall.

The following topics were discussed at the June 18, 2013, meeting:

1. Resolution 547 was presented for approval, which allows the City to receive state revenues. This is a yearly resolution that Council approves. Council passed Resolution 547.
2. 2014 Budget – The 2014 budget was presented to Council for adoption. Resolution 548 adopting the approved 2014 budget was passed.
3. Council meeting July 2 – In prior years, Council has canceled the first meeting of July due to the holiday. Council canceled the July 2, 2013 meeting.
4. Chamber of Commerce lease – The Chamber requested a lease from Council to store Chamber materials in a spare room in Council chambers. Council agreed to the lease, on the condition that if the police department is able to move sooner than anticipated, the lease would need to be revisited, as the police department would have priority.
5. Update Computer Reporting System – Chief Richman advised Council that it appears they are going forward with the mandatory update and requested permission from Council to update when he was required to do so. Council granted approval.
6. A meeting with the CTUIR Board of Trustees convened after the adjournment of the regular Council meeting.
