City of Pilot Rock

The next scheduled City Council meeting will be held on **Tuesday, November 5, 2013 @ 7 pm in Council Chambers.**

1. A public hearing was held regarding a variance for sign for the Baptist Church. Council approved a 4x8 sign to be erected on the corner of SW 6th and SW Birch.
2. A public hearing was held regarding a variance to build a garage at 180 NE Cherry, with reduced set backs. Council approved the variance.
3. Teri Porter informed Council that due to an early payoff penalty fee and the fact that the interest would not be reduced until July 2014, the lump sum payment on the LOCAP loan would need to be \$105,000, rather than \$110,000. Council agreed.
4. Councilor Porter resigned as he will be moving out of the City limits.
5. Citizens with questions regarding the public safety surcharge are encouraged to submit them in writing to City Hall. The questions will be addressed at the next Council meeting.

Dual Credit and the Eastern Promise

Pilot Rock High School is working in cooperation with BMCC and Eastern Oregon University to provide students the opportunity to receive college credit. For the last 12 years students have been able to receive dual credits from BMCC. Last year was the first year students could receive college credit by proficiency through the Eastern Promise. During a recent visit to PRHS, Kris Mulvihill, the coordinator of Eastern Promise, calculated the number of college credits a student could receive at PRHS. If a student chooses to take all the dual credit classes offered, he/she would have 70 percent of an AAOT degree completed by graduation from PRHS. Currently classes in the following disciplines are being offered: math, writing; speech; ag business, equine, animal, plants and crops; photography; computer science; health; Spanish; and educational tutoring.


Thank You!


