Heating & Ventilation

Contractors were interviewed in February. YMC, Inc. had the winning bid, and has already made great strides in the work required. During spring break, they installed the initial ducting in attic areas in the elementary, junior high, and high school. The boiler in the elementary school was removed by Hatley Construction to make room for new equipment to be placed in that area.

The finishing ductwork was started on June 14th. Building 'B' is the first to be worked on, followed by Building 'A'. The new heating and ventilation system, consisting of state of the art heat pumps, will not only keep the temperature

comfortable, but will also circulate fresh air which lessens the CO₂, and helps keep kids more alert. Individualized direct digital controls will be part of the new system, allowing remote control. If there is a problem, an alarm will notify the maintenance staff no matter where they are, and the situation can usually be assessed and corrected through the computer system.

Another cost saver is the way that this system uses VRV, Variant Refrigerant Volume, which re-cycles

the hot and cold air that is already present to the parts of the building that need it, without the energy loss of pulling in outside air and heating or cooling it.

Gymnasium & Cafeteria



There were several bids to choose from for the architectural contract for storage additions at both the elementary and junior high, as well as upgrades to exterior doors at the elementary school. Mike Becker Construction from La Grande won the bid. Becker poured footings June 9th for the Junior High cafeteria storage area, which is a highly visible project.

Roofing

Most of the roofing work is done. Some of the roofing upgrades that were done last summer were funded by this bond. There are some cuts that will require the existing roof to have new curbs and flashings for the new heating and ventilation equipment. Umpqua Roofing, who did the extensive roofing overhaul last year, will be doing those roofing fixes this summer.

Electricity & Technology

The electrical system upgrades will begin in the summer. Updates will be noted as progress is made.

High School Science Rooms

New counter tops and sinks will be installed this summer.


SENIOR CENTER NEWS
