Heating & Ventilation

All projects are on the downhill stretch, and are still on track to be completed on time. Systems are being checked out now by the balancing contractor, a third party who verifies that equipment meets design requirements. The contractor estimates the Jr. High is 90% complete, the High School is about 80% complete, and the Elementary School is

75% complete. Commissioning and some clean up will begin shortly.

Gymnasium & Cafeteria



The fabric duct system in the high school gym collapses when air is not blowing, and if a ball hits it, it will give and not break like metal ducting. It can also be easily retracted, cleaned, or replaced as needed.



The Junior High work is almost done. The storage area is enclosed, sheet rock is up, painters are finishing up, and the rooms are cool and well ventilated.



Electricity & Technology



The entry to the HS has turned into an electrical supply store?
