Letter to Concerned Citizens

To those concerned,

I am writing to address the petition to remove the planters from downtown. I would like to first say that, although voted on and approved by the city council, the decision for these planters were not made by the Mayor, not by the council, but by the citizens whom attended the series of community meetings that led up to a vote by the citizens themselves. The community meetings were held a little over a year ago and were advertised in the newsletter and on the reader board well enough in advance so that anyone wanting to express their opinion would be able to attend and make their voice heard. There were several options presented each evening that were eventually voted on by the 40+ people present. That vote was to follow through with the planters downtown. I would like to urge everyone to please pick up a newsletter each and every month and attend an occasional council meeting. Any meetings that would have an impact on the community will be posted in the newsletter. This way if anyone wants to have a say, or vote, in any upcoming projects, they will be able to do so.

Community Gardens

Greetings Gardeners! We are very busy with the development of our Elm Street site: Our high school construction class is building raised bed boxes for this site and there are many flats of seedlings in the high school greenhouse for planting time. Rick Lynch has generously volunteered to head up a **work party this Sunday afternoon at 1:30** at our Main Street site to amend soil. Please join us with shovels and wheelbarrows to make our soil healthy and productive! People who love **flowers and herbs** are invited to adopt one of these beds—we hope to have mature, beautiful displays in these beds in time for Pilot Rock Community Days in August. There is still plenty of room in our organization for helpers: We would like to involve young people in our garden program by providing them with a **4-H gardening program**. Maybe you or someone you know would like to rise to this challenge. The city has generously offered us space for a **composting project**, but we need someone to head up such a project, also. On a smaller scale, a **worm composting** project would be a great project for young folks—care to take that one on? If you are a carpenter, maybe you would like to **create a communication board** on the back of our Main Street site sponsor sign. Please call me at 443-2905 if you would like to share your gifts and talents in creating our local food system through community gardening, or if you would like to reserve a bed for gardening this year. Clubs, churches and organizations are welcome to sign up for beds—you may share one with a neighbor if you like, too. Our next meeting will be meeting on May 10, at 6:00 in council chambers.
