The Mayor's Minute---or Two!

**Cen-10<sup>+</sup>-nial ?**

It appears that we have resolved the issue of Pilot Rock's Centennial/incorporation date after many months of dealing with conflicting dates, searching City archives, library archives, County archives and finally the State of Oregon Archives! This process started back in February and has concluded by establishing the date as 1902---not 1911 or 1912 or other dates thrown in the mix. There were annexations in 1911 and 1912 which may have added to the confusion, as well as the Charter being established in 1912---but nothing was officially recorded if there was a reincorporation in 1912. This entire process started when we began talking about a centennial celebration---in either 1911 or 1912---and see where it led! I am attaching the email from Gary Halverson for your information, and also the City and Library have copies the documents if you'd like to look at them. So---it appears that we will plan for a centennial + 10 in 2012 since we missed the original date ;-). Special thanks to all who helped---especially Jean Hemphill, Gary Halverson, Jim Whittaker and City Staff! It's been enlightening. The Oregon Blue Book's next edition will reflect the change from 1911 to 1902.

Several opinions appear to exist on the date of the incorporation of Pilot Rock. All I can provide is that which is in the Official Documents record series in the Secretary of State's records here at the Oregon State Archives. Reference Archivist Austin Schulz and I dug around in the published messages and documents, general laws, and special laws but found no mention of any reincorporation.

Attached are several PDFs of the original Official Documents:

- 1.) The Pilot Rock index card showing all documents that were recorded related to the City of Pilot Rock during that period.
- 2.) The original incorporation in 1902.
- 3.) An annexation in 1911.
- 4.) An annexation in 1912.

**Cen-10<sup>+</sup>-nial ?**

A research project to update the information in the Oregon Blue Book had already tagged the incorporation date to change from 1911 to 1902 based on the above mentioned original incorporation document. The next print Oregon Blue Book will reflect this. Austin and I wonder if the 1911 and 1912 dates that are quoted in different sources are actually referring to the annexations and not an actual incorporation. I suppose that other possibilities include the reincorporation not being filed with the Secretary of State or that it was filed but not recorded.

Anyway, here is a Web page that doesn't cite its sources, but refers to 1903 and 1912 dates, just to muddy the water!
