Heating & Ventilation

Much of the work being done now is inside where the public can't see it. Crews are hard at work in almost every part of the buildings - classrooms, crawl spaces, and roofs. The contractor, YMC, Inc., is well into installing the VRV heating and ventilation systems. They have installed over a dozen of these same systems in the last two years, which have been used worldwide for over 25 years.

The contractor says they are about 35% complete at this point.

Innovative Air is working on the large heating and ventilation roof units.



Hallways look quite a bit different than they did at the end of the school year! Equipment is being moved in, and interior heating and ventilation units are going into place.

Gymnasium & Cafeteria



The concrete floor has been poured for the storage area off of the Jr. High cafeteria.

Just outside, Mike Becker's crew is working on the new retaining wall that will shore up the edge of the lawn and improve the parking areas.



COFFEE FILTERS---Who knew! And you can buy 1,000

at the Dollar Tree for almost nothing--- even the large ones.

1. Cover bowls or dishes when cooking in the microwave.

Coffee filters make excellent covers.

2. Clean windows, mirrors, and chrome... Coffee filters are lint-free so they'll leave windows sparkling.

3. Protect China by separating your good dishes with a coffee filter between each dish.

4. Filter broken cork from wine. If you break the cork when opening a wine bottle, filter the wine through a coffee filter.

5. Protect a cast-iron skillet. Place a coffee filter in the skillet to absorb moisture and prevent rust.

6. Apply shoe polish. Ball up a lint-free coffee filter..

7. Recycle frying oil. After frying, strain oil through a sieve lined with a coffee filter.

8. Weigh chopped foods. Place chopped ingredients in a coffee filter on a kitchen scale.

9. Hold tacos. Coffee filters make convenient wrappers for messy foods.

10. Stop the soil from leaking out of a plant pot. Line a plant pot with a coffee filter to prevent the soil from going through the drainage holes.
