2. Jimmy Doherty of Eastern Oregon Waste Management, will ask Council to allow him to apply for a DEQ grant on behalf of the City. The grant is to be used for a recycling project.
3. Tom Callahan has asked to be put on the agenda to express his concern regarding cats they may have been left behind after the City tore down the old house at the foot of the stairs.
4. Council will also be provided with a draft of the renewal of the Centrytel franchise agreement. Council will be asked to take action on the renewal at the November 1, 2016, Council meeting.
