Recently I was notified of a female by the name of Michelle Waddell who states she was born in 1979. This Michelle person is contacting younger males in an attempt to get them to accept her as a friend. Then this Michelle is trying to get the person's private email account to send inappropriate information, regarding photos.

The Pilot Rock Police is aware and we are working on educating the people of the concerns, along with trying to track this female. I am encouraging you to spend a little time and talk with your children about only accepting friends or asking people to be their friends that they actually know. Most children are going to feel that you are invading their privacy, but my comment would be to the children "we are trying to protect you not invade your privacy".
