## What's Going on? By Teri Bacus

It's an exciting time in the City of Pilot Rock. Finally, after almost three years of planning, the Lagoon project is on track. Most of the gravity collection network and lagoon system began operation in 1958 and has a capacity of approximately 250,000 gallons per day. The improvements include abandoning one of the existing lift stations and installing a new lift station which will connect to a new pressure pipeline approximately 4100 feet downstream. Approved contractor Silver Creek Contracting LLC will be constructing a new wastewater treatment facility which includes about 8500 linear feet of various sizes of sewer piping. Approximately 50 acres will be used for six new lagoons. The project is expected to be completed by August 2020. The City will be having a groundbreaking ceremony to kick off this huge project at the Lagoon site and all citizens are welcome to attend. The ceremony is on June 6, 2019 at 11am and refreshments with cake will be provided.



\*\*Lunch will be served out of the food truck at the pool this year , kids taking swim lessons must make other arrangements for transportation to the swim park and a lunch. A seasonal pass may be purchased if the swim lesson kids will be staying at the swim park and riding home on the bus. Parents will be responsible for checking the child in with the swim bus director when she arrives at the Swim park at Noon each day.

\*<u>Swim Bus July 2nd – August 1st</u> Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday!! No bus on July 4<sup>th</sup> due to it's a Holiday.

COST (Includes transportation to and from the Aquatic Center, Lunch, and Supervision)

<u>Single Day passes</u> \$4.50 per day (\$.50 cash to city hall for bus pass) and (\$4.00 cash to the Pendleton Pool). OR \$40 for all 22 days!! Bus leaves the elementary school @ 11:20 and the High School @ 11:30.

Every Swimmer must have a permission/information sheet filled out from City Hall PRIOR to riding the bus. There will be no sharing of passes this year.
