Meetings are scheduled for April 15 & April 29 at 7pm.

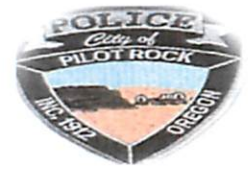

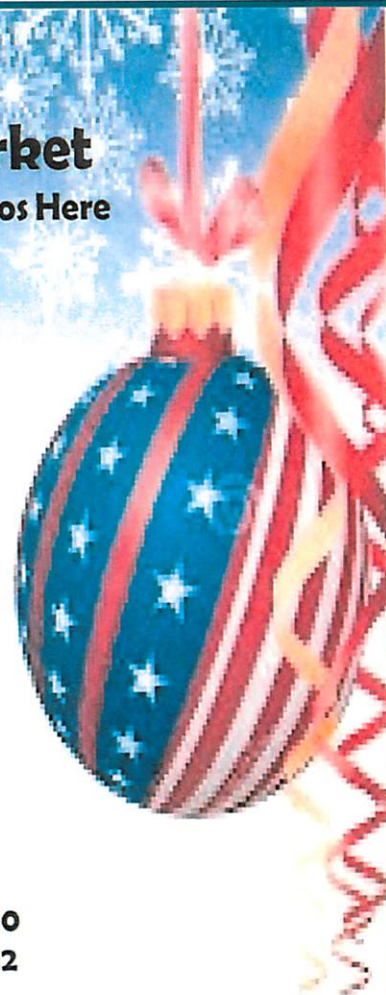
