Monday June 6 – Closed

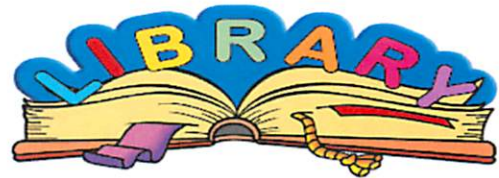

On Monday June 13, the Library will return to its normal hours.



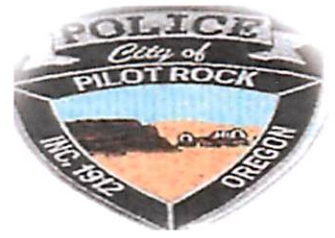

Kayak makes 3 trips per day from Pendleton to Pilot Rock and community members can connect to the city of Pendleton (free) bus service to get around the city. The Kayak bus known as the Rocket stops at the pavilion at 6:42 a.m., 11:55 a.m. and 5:49 p.m. For a return trip please use the 6:42 or 11:55 scheduled times. We leave Pendleton, Til Taylor Park, 5:19, City Hall, 5:24 and Walmart at 5:29 p.m. each day Monday through Friday for return trip to Pilot Rock.

Occasionally we have to cancel a route due to staffing shortages so please call our Dispatch line between 4:00 a.m. and 8:30 p.m. to make sure the service is available.

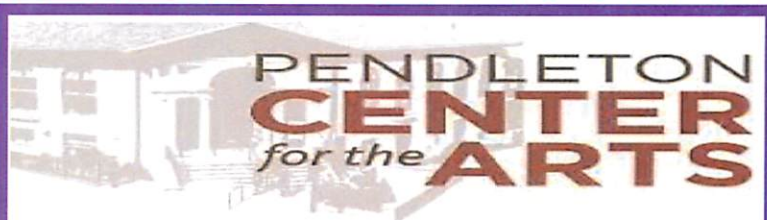

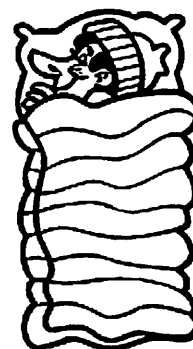
