Every town is an important part of the American story. Make sure Pilot Rock's story is told by responding to the 2020 Census - the count of everyone living in the United States. Census responses provide data that can attract new businesses and the jobs that come with them. The data also informs where over \$675 billion in federal funding is spent each year in states and communities. That includes money for things like, Medicare Part B, Special education and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. The money that the City of Pilot Rock receives is based on population so your response counts.

The National Guard will be landing a Chinook helicopter on the baseball field at 1:00 PM on February 20th. Students will be able to go inside to learn about the opportunities available through joining the army reserves. The community needs to be aware of the landing and to not be concerned.
